Vicar's Letter

Dear Friends

Churchill famously said, "I am fond of pigs. A cat looks down on a man; a dog looks up to a man. But a pig will look you in the eye and see his equal".

I'm not sure how true that is, but I too am very fond of pigs. In my home village of Freckenham we have run for the last few years a small pig co-op, whereby up to 8 families club together to buy a few rare breed piglets, and raise them, sharing costs and feeding duties. It's a great community activity, and we have the satisfaction of knowing that we have produced our own high quality free range pork; the children involved have learnt not only where their food comes from, but various valuable lessons about the responsibility of caring for livestock and of co-operation with others.

This year we have an additional reason for rearing our five Gloucestershire Old Spot piglets: we have acquired a piece of derelict land behind our garden, once farmland but abandoned to brambles, nettles and bindweed for many years. Everyone told me I would need to use industrial-strength weed killer before I could create the wildflower meadow I dreamed of. I hated the idea of that, and I knew from experience that nothing clears a bit of overgrown land quicker than a gang of hungry piglets. They are never happier than when digging up and chomping juicy roots and it's a joy to see them 'rootling' their way around the field. It's easy to see that with their strong shoulders and plough-like snouts they are designed to do exactly this. Often I feel, when I am pottering about feeding, watering or just giving them a lovely scratch behind the ears, that I too am designed exactly for this: I feel perfectly at peace.

How blessed we are when we find out who we are and what we are designed for. Each of us will have activities that bring us peace, whether it is walking, gardening, music, being with our loved ones or any number of other things. It's a very individual thing. However the bible suggests that there is another source of peace that is right for us all: Jesus offers "peace - but not the kind the world gives" - every time I pronounce the blessing I speak of 'the peace that passes all understanding'. St Augustine summed it up by saying "Our hearts are restless until they find their rest in you" We are designed to know and love God. My prayer for each of us is that we will find that special peace: that we will look God in the eye and love him, and know ourselves to be loved.

The present boiler is 25 years old, and, as anyone who has been in the church recently will agree, it no longer efficiently provides enough heat to keep people warm, so the new one is urgently needed.





BARTON MILLS BAPTIST CHURCH

The number of hate crimes in this country has increased considerably. Most recently hate letters have been distributed around various cities in the UK and two people have been left dangerously ill caused by a nerve agent administered to them. The latter part of last month we remembered what we, as Christians, regard as the greatest hate crime in history as recorded in the Bible, when Jesus was brutally murdered and left to die on a cross of wood.

During His earthly ministry Jesus performed some wonderful miracles of healing. He did no wrong, was perfect in every way, yet there were still people who hated Him enough to want Him to die. Even today we are told some people love to hate us! According to one estimate there are 200 million persecuted believers in the world today. In John 3 v 20 we read Jesus said "Everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed". Jesus is that Light. When He walked this earth, people hated Him because He exposed the darkness of their sin. The same applies today so it is our task to be channels of God's Love and Light even if we are hated in return.

At the end of the first paragraph above we were reminded of Jesus' crucifixion, a result of hate, however, the opposite occurred three days later when Jesus was miraculously raised from the dead, resulting in a time of great rejoicing, not only then but for us now in the 21st century. The opposite of Hate is Love and if there is one thing believers in Jesus should be known for, it is Love. The word Love appears in the Bible more than 500 times. The essence of the gospel is Love, as we see in John Ch 3 v16 & 17, "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son that whosoever believeth in Him should not perish but have everlasting life, For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved". This Easter, let us think of the Love of the Father that led to the priceless gift of His Son, which was part of His eternal plan (Ephesians Ch 1 v 4 to 5, Ch 3 v 11) God's gift of love should fill us with deep gratitude and joy.




