Vicar's Letter

War and Prayer for Peace

The conflict in Ukraine cannot be far from our minds at the present time. The images of the destruction there and the displaced people are hard to watch and particularly as I find it hard to believe that Russia's borders were really under any threat at all. All this devastation because one person felt threatened!

Within the Christian Church our focus at this time of the year is on another occasion when something similar happened. Jesus in his ministry told people that there was only one God and encouraged people to worship the one true God. The leaders of the Roman empire did not like this as it undermined their authority. Indeed, the Caesars, the ultimate Romans leaders, proclaimed themselves as gods and expected people to worship them! The leaders of God's people, the Pharisees and the teachers of the Jewish law, were not happy either. They felt that their positions as the people who dictated how God's law was to be interpreted and lived out by the Jewish people were being undermined by this new teaching that Jesus was proclaiming. He was showing people through his actions and his words that God's ways were, and still are, of love and justice and peace.

As we approach Holy Week and Good Friday where God's Son, Jesus Christ, died on the cross because those in positions of power and authority felt challenged and threatened by him as he spoke of God's ways, I ask that we all pray that God will turn the hearts of the leaders of those countries who wage war against others that they will pursue His ways of love and justice and peace. And using the words of Jesus from the cross, I pray "Father, forgive them for they know not what they do". Will you pray also?

National Highways have appointed Mott MacDonald to carry out surveys at the Fiveways A11 junction. The A11 Fiveways Junction is one of the pipeline schemes National Highways are looking to improve, which the government may consider for future investment as part of the third Road Investment Strategy (RIS3) to improve traffic flow which will run from 2025 to 2030. Residents who live within 500m of Fiveways should have received a survey from National Highways in regard to this in early March.

NATURE NOTES.

By now I hope you have all had sightings of BRIMSTONE BUTTERFLIES, usually the first and last species to be seen each year. The



upper side of the wings of the males are sulphur yellow and it seems that the word "butterfly" was first used for this species and then applied to others. The female's upper side is much paler but both sexes have an orange spot on each wing. Their caterpillars are dependent on buckthorn and alder buckthorn for their food but adults are strongly attracted to wild flowers for

nectar and hibernate over winter and live for up to a year.




