# Vicar's Letter ......A Letter from our new Curate

What's a curate, I hear you say? In a word, it's a kind of trainee vicar. To introduce myself, my name is David Butcher, I was ordained at Bury Cathedral on Saturday 30<sup>th</sup> June 2018 and am now starting a three year period of training being supervised by Sandie our Vicar and working alongside the team of ordained and lay people who serve the four churches in Barton Mills, Freckenham, West Row and Worlington. As a 'Self-Supporting Minister', I will serve as an unpaid, part-time volunteer. I also have a paid 'day-job'; I work for the Church as the Safeguarding Adviser to the Diocese.

The ordination itself was great. A terrific day at the Cathedral, gloriously sunny, (too warm in a thick black cassock!), surrounded by family and friends, one of 25 new Deacons ordained by our Bishop Martin Seeley. It was emotional, humbling and exciting for what the future might hold.

So now I'm a Reverend, but not a Priest yet; technically I have been ordained Deacon, which means literally 'one who serves'. Here's an extract from the ordination service that explains something of what I have 'signed up' to ...

"Deacons ... are to serve the community in which they are set, bringing to the Church the needs and hopes of all the people. They are to work with their fellow members in searching out the poor and weak, the sick and lonely and those who are oppressed and powerless, reaching into the forgotten corners of the world, that the love of God may be made visible.

Deacons share in the pastoral ministry of the Church and in leading God's people in worship. They preach the word and bring the needs of the world before the Church in intercession. They accompany those searching for faith and bring them to baptism. ... they distribute communion and minister to the sick and housebound.

Deacons ... are to seek nourishment from the Scriptures; They are to be faithful in prayer, expectant and watchful for the signs of God's presence, as he reveals his kingdom among us."

So, no pressure! With all of that in mind, I look forward to meeting you; serving you in any of the ways described and joining in where God is already at work in our villages.

I am excited at the prospect!






