

#### **BARTON MILLS PARISH COUNCIL**

#### **SPEED INDICATOR DEVICE (SID)**

The SID which is owned by the Parish Council is rotated between three positions in the village, Worlington Road, Church Lane and Mildenhall Road.

Data from the SID from April to October has been downloaded and analysed, the data showed the following:

Mildenhall Road - 97% of vehicle were recorded travelling at a speed of 30mph or below

Church Lane - 74% of vehicles were recorded travelling at a speed of 30mph or below and 24% between 30mph and 40mph.

Worlington Road – 34% of vehicles were recorded traveling at 30mph or below, 57% between 30mph and 40mph and 9% between 40mph and 50mph. This data has been passed onto Suffolk Police who have confirmed they will place their own Speed Detection Radar on Worlington Road for one week to gather their own evidence, and that the speed enforcement team will be asked to carry out more regular checks on Worlington Road.

#### **MALLARDS BRIDGE**

Following our previous update, unfortunately there has been a delay to the works as further trees required felling. The contractors left the site early November but plan to return late November with the works being completed before Christmas if the weather allows.


Our next meeting will be on Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> January 2022 at 2.00pm in the Village Hall.
