Vicar's Letter

Father's Day

We have all heard of Mothering Sunday. Most of us have taken the opportunity to buy cards and flowers to say "Thank You" to our mothers for the part they have played in our lives right from the moment we were born. What we hear much less about is Father's Day which is held on the third Sunday of June. The idea of a special day to honour fathers was introduced by Sonora Smart Dodd in the United States. It hasn't caught on like Mothering Sunday has but fathers do play a big part in our lives. Mothers decide to be mothers long before dads do. A mother carries her baby for nine months, giving her an opportunity to grow into being a mother. Dads, however, go about their daily routine, pretty much unaffected by what's going on inside the womb. He may be supportive but until baby is actually born he is pretty much just an observer.

At the birth of his new baby the father's world takes on new meaning. It is now, as he looks into the face of this new life that he has to make the decision to *become* a father. It is a decision that will alter his life, schedule, direction, and priorities, as he chooses to be the good father to the tiny life in his arms. Fathering a child is, for most people, not difficult being a father is.

I heard the story once of a man who had promised his son that he would come and watch him play in a special ball game his team was playing in. He was so looking forward to his dad coming to watch and talked about it endlessly. Then his dad received an invitation from the President of the United States to attend a special function at the White House, on the same day as his son's ball game. Well, the White House got on just fine without him. His son, on the other hand, was the proudest boy on the field as he played with the voice of his father cheering him on from the sidelines. Now that is being a role model and that is being a father. Most of it is not about doing special things or about doing anything unusual. It is just about doing the one thing that is most important and that is simply being there.

BARTON MILLS BAPTIST CHURCH

Last year I was unable to visit my friends in Florida for Thanksgiving, the first time in 16 years. Sadly, they experienced a terrible hurricane, rarely experienced in that part of the US. They have had their roof replaced, but are still waiting for repairs to the interior to be accomplished. At the height of one of these storms the strong winds can reach 150 miles an hour and can be devastating yet no one on earth has ever seen the wind that causes this destruction and inconvenience.

During Jesus earthly ministry He had known each of His disciples intimately, they were only human and when He was crucified they must have been devastated. After three days He rose from the dead and appeared to them on several occasions. They must have wanted these visits to continue indefinitely – but this was not to be, however. He had told them in Acts 1 v 5 "... ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence" and in John 14 v 16, He said "I will pray the Father and He will give you another Comforter, that He may abide with you forever". As He promised in Acts 2 v 1 - 4, we read "Now when the **Day of Pentecost** was fully come, they were all with one accord in one place. Suddenly there came from Heaven as of a rushing mighty wind. and it filled all the house where they were sitting. "And they were all filled with the Holy Ghost" - this was Pentecost. Those who experienced that wind didn't see it. but as a result of it, were never the same again. Their lives changed dramatically -they went forth victoriously proclaiming the good news that a resurrected Saviour was offering salvation to every repentant sinner. We may not experience a "mighty rushing wind", and we no longer have a holiday to remind us of it, but Christians all over the world will remember it as Whit Sunday, this year the 9th of June. the Day of Pentecost.

We get frustrated and spiritually exhausted when we try to work things out on our own terms. We fail to draw on the power of the Holy Spirit who lives within us yet His presence can become real and powerful when we rely on Him. The great news is that this Power of Pentecost is not reserved for the highly gifted, it is available to all believers in Christ who want to serve Him. The early disciples were only humble men yet God saw fit to bestow on them this great Gift which would be to them a Comforter. Today we too can receive that gift if we will only believe His word and put our complete trust in Him. The Holy Spirit is not some mystical force but a personal Being who lives within every follower of the Lord Jesus Christ. This Whitsuntide let us reflect on that day when the Holy Spirit came to indwell all believers. Jesus can't be in two places at once, but the Holy Spirit can.


