Vicar's Letter

(Curate's Letter)

People always say that it is a sure sign that we are getting older when the years just seem to fly by. So, I'm obviously getting older ... no surprises there then! It is almost a year since I was appointed to the role of Curate in our group of four parishes, under the watchful eye of our Parish Priest, Rev Sandie.

My year as a Deacon is fast coming to an end and the next stage will be to be a Priest in our four parishes, whilst remaining a Curate for another couple of years.

Up until this point my ministry has always been part-time and something of a secondary consideration behind my 'day-job' as the Safeguarding Advisor to the Church of England in this county. Safeguarding is a vitally important function to ensure that the most vulnerable people in our communities are protected from harm, and that essential work will continue, just not with me at the helm!. I have taken the step of resigning from that position in order to devote more time to my role as Curate in Barton Mills, West Row, Freckenham and Worlington, and also to a new role as Police Chaplain.

This has not been a step that I have taken lightly, but it will free up time for me to do more in the parishes than I have been able to do up to now. More time to be involved in the things that clergy are about, visiting the sick, encouraging the lonely or isolated, supporting the ministry team in these parishes, helping families with funeral arrangements, or weddings or baptisms, encouraging new believers or simply answering the questions of anyone who may like to know more about faith and why I believe what I do, in fact a vast array of things that up until now I have just not had the time for!

BARTON MILLS W I - NEWS AND INFORMATION

April 19

Retired Fingerprint expert David Smith was our Speaker this month. He had worked in a civilian capacity for the Metropolitan Police for thirty nine and a half years and had seen many changes and experienced many horrific scenes of crime. Fingerprints were first used in the United Kingdom in 1901 by New Scotland Yard. There had been various trials beforehand and Sir Edward Henry had had some success during his time in India and his efforts were adopted by the Metropolitan Police. Up until this point the police had used body measurements to identify felons – arm length, forearm length, height, girth etc and many more but not scientific enough for a secure conviction. Today, not only are police forces around the UK linked into one system for identification but there is an international exchange. He showed us how to take fingerprints in its simplest form using the finest of powder and special tape. Progress has been made to make this so much easier rather than printing one finger at a time both hands can now be done by computer which is stored electronically


and now be shared by any police force. He told us about some of the cases he had been involved with some amusing most harrowing. A fascinating evening.

View the 600 year-old Mildenhall Warren Lodge and learn how rabbits were farmed for their meat and their fur.

Visit the Rex Graham Reserve nearby to see largest colony of military orchids in Britain.

This is the annual opportunity to go inside the Lodge and also to see the orchids.



Directions: The warren lodge is situated in Mildenhall Woods, north of the Barton Mills Roundabout. From the A1065, the minor road (on the left coming south from Brandon and on the right coming north from Barton Mills) is signed 'Household Waste Site. Turn here and drive past the Household Waste Site to the Forestry Commission car-parking area, signed as 'Mildenhall Warren Lodge'. The Lodge is about ten minutes walk up the hill. Temporary signage will be on the A1065. Grid Ref TL735752.

The Rex Graham Reserve is situated at Ride 306 in Mildenhall Woods, on the A1101 towards Bury St Edmunds, off the five-ways roundabout at Barton Mills. Parking is via ride 306 and will be signed off A1101 on the open day (locked at all other times). There is a boardwalk and steep steps down to the pit and no dogs are allowed. Grid ref: TL 737746.




