

Vicar's Letter

A view from the Vicar.

As I write this short piece for the Barton Miller I am conscious that you are having a number of different ministers filling this spot for you. The 'Lark and Lee' group of churches, of which St Mary's is part, are currently in a vacancy as we wait for a suitable candidate to apply for the position as Team Rector covering the group.

My wife Caroline and I served this group initially as Lay Readers and latterly in our respective curacies and both of us loved serving in Barton Mills where we felt very comfortable

and greatly supported.

We have just returned from a really eventful pilgrimage to the Holy Land with a group of 21 people led by your previous Vicar, Revd David Everett. It was a wonderful and enlightening experience to walk in the footsteps of Jesus to many places that we are familiar with through passages in the Bible.

I say it was 'really eventful' because whilst we were there on 7th October, Hamas sent rockets into Israel and the whole sorry situation of war developed from that moment. Mercifully, I have never personally been in an active war zone before; not an experience that I am keen to repeat! The contrast of seeing tanks and troops moving along roads to fortify areas that are otherwise so Holy and special to both Muslims and Christians; indeed to Israeli's and Palestinians was very stark.

As is usually the way, the people that are hurt the most in any conflict are the innocent bystanders, whether they are Jewish or Palestinians. All we can do at this stage, as in Ukraine, is to pray that opposing sides will come together in some form of compromise negotiations to bring about peace and safety for all people in the region. Wars or conflicts are never solved by bullets and bombs, only ever over a negotiating

table.


NEW CHURCH GATES A CORONATION YEAR PROJECT


As reported in the October Barton Miller, we hope to put new gates at the front of the churchyard, opening onto the road, as a Coronation Year project. We have already received several donations - many thanks to those who have contributed - but we do need to raise more funds, so more contributions will be gratefully received.

The Church P.C.C. have chosen an iroko hard wood design, which, it is hoped, everyone will agree will look good and be suitable. It will be similar to the sketch shown here, but some details may be different.

LAND FOR SALE, MILDENHALL ROAD

A parcel of land measuring 3.6 acres, located adjacent to the footpath between Barton Mills and Mildenhall is for sale, priced at £80,000.

The land falls outside the permitted development area and residential development is therefore extremely unlikely so the land would not be purchased with a view to develop in the future.

The Parish Council are considering purchasing this land but this cannot be decided without input from parishioners.

There are four options to fund the purchase of the land:

Loan, repayable via the precept
 Grant Funding, if available
 Contributions from willing residents
 A combination of options 1 to 3

The Parish Council would like to ask residents to get in contact with their thoughts on this proposal:

-Would you want the Parish Council to purchase the land?
-Would you be willing to contribute towards the cost either via donation or the precept?

-What would you like to see the land being used for?
-Do you think this could be a valuable asset for the village?

As we head into the late Autumn month of November we leave behind the warm and sunny days that have marked our Summer and early Autumn. We have the exciting and yet worrying prospect of Christmas ahead, with all that entails.

The coming months bring financial considerations to us all as we meet the challenges of the rises in the cost of living coupled with Christmas expenditure and heating our homes. For some though these challenges are added to by the loneliness that often comes with our advancing years and sometimes distance from family members.

The Good Neighbour Scheme exists not only to help tackle those small jobs that are needed to ease living on one's own but also to provide friendship through befriending, calling in for a chat and collecting shopping or prescriptions, as required. It can of course be the same for couples isolated from family and friends for whom those same befriending volunteers can be a lifeline to providing support. We are also able to put villagers in touch with other appropriate support organisations in cases where we are not equipped to provide specialist help. This is done through our links with a County-wide support network.

We are making the preparations for our annual Christmas Coffee Morning in the Village Hall, and we hope that you will be able to come along for free teas, coffees and cakes on Saturday 25th November from 10.00am until 12.00 noon. This is a splendid opportunity for villagers to meet up and socialise. For those who might have difficulty getting to the Village Hall we can arrange to collect you by car and take you home afterwards.

I would like to remind readers that our services, which are free of any charge, are designed to support villagers across the entire Parish of Barton Mills. The fruiting bodies, known as mushrooms or fungi, emerge in autumn to aid reproduction by spreading their spores. We have 15,000 species of fungi in the U.K., some with interesting names! A few examples are Dead man's fingers, Fly agaric, Jelly ear, judge's wig, Octopus stinkhorn and witches butter, to name but a few. The red and white toadstool Fly agaric may be familiar from illustrations in children's books with a mouse or elf perched on the top!

Some animals will have been feeding furiously to fatten up ready for hibernation. Only three of our natives truly hibernate – bats, Hazel dormice and Hedgehogs. Some others, Badgers and Red squirrels for example, go into torpor. They slow down their metabolism and heart rate but often emerge to feed during warm, sunny days. Even some butterflies, ladybirds or moths can hibernate. That Peacock or Red admiral you find in your garden shed is not dead but merely in hibernation ready to emerge in the spring.
